

# The NYC Residential Lobbies That Feel Like Five-Star Hotels

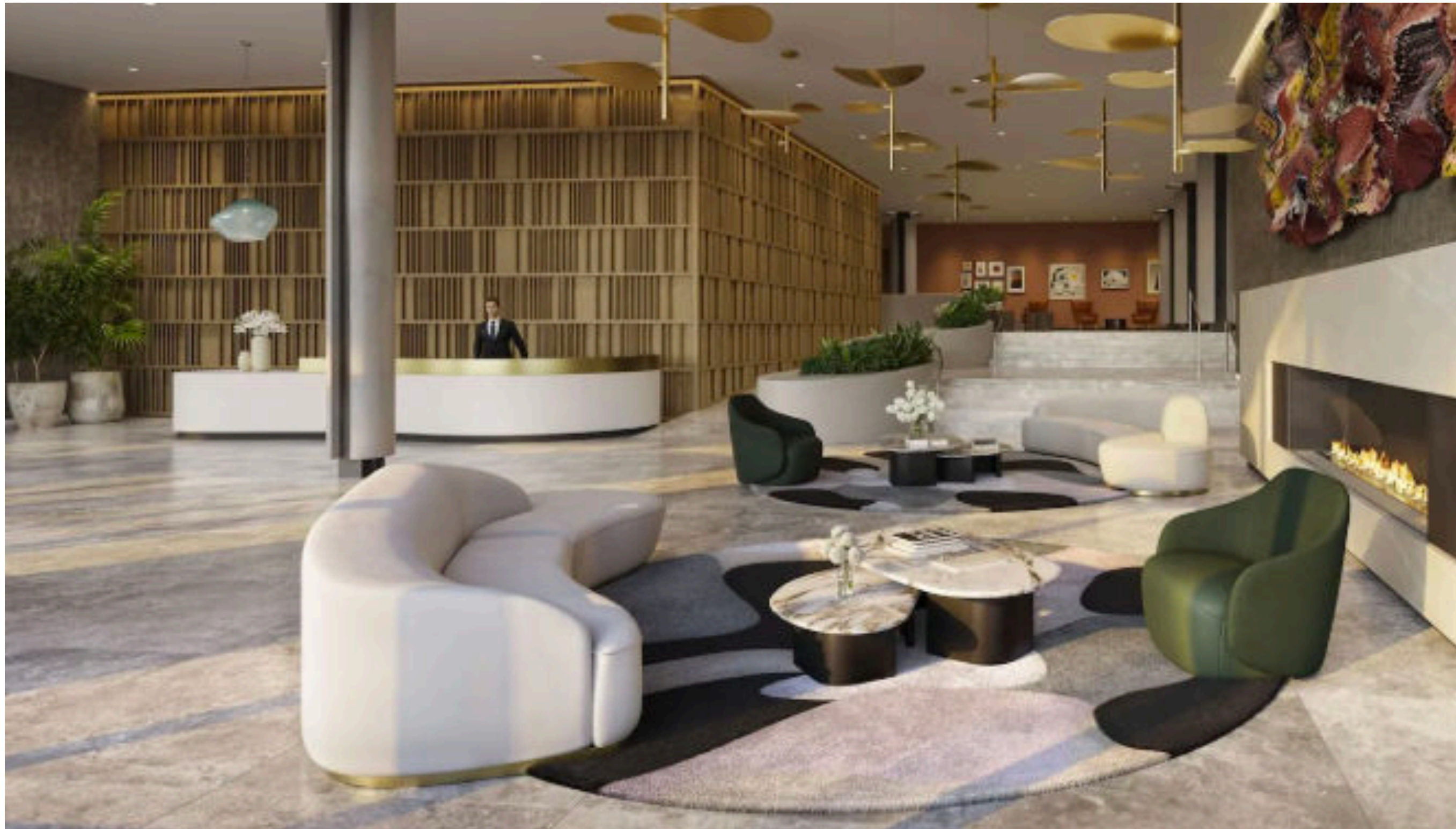
